Bible Study Curriculum

It is with much joy that we announce to you Aldersgate's Summer Theme for 2016: **Iesus Is!**

As the writers of our curriculum put it, "the focus of this study is not on who Jesus was, but on who Jesus Is."

Each day, campers will explore this topic, answering the question, "Who is Jesus?"

The daily themes are:

Monday- Jesus is the Son of God
Tuesday- Jesus is Our Healer
Wednesday- Jesus is Our Teacher
Thursday- Jesus is Our Savior
Friday- Jesus is Our Friend


