Summer Camp Update

This summer at Aldersgate, if you shouted out "Stand Firm!", you would hear groups of campers and staff respond with "And Suit Up!!" This was our theme for Summer Camp this year, as each day we studied a different piece of the Armor of God. We are thrilled to report that the Summer Camp ministry at Aldersgate is alive and well. We saw 20 more campers this summer than in 2017 with room to grow. We had 25 people on staff this summer, including 6 internationals from countries around the world! At Vespers, "My Lighthouse" has become one of the campers' favorite songs. Some of the most popular activities this summer were Outdoor Survival Skills, Culinary Arts, Waterfront Activities, and of course Gaga Ball- a camper favorite. Campers had a blast being silly and sharing their talents at our variety show we call TML, and felt the power of the Holy Spirit as they walked the prayer labyrinth and prayed with each other. Each week. campers filled out an evaluation asking what they liked and their ideas to make camp even better. We also asked what they learned. Here are some excerpts from some of those camper evaluations:

BBQ Meatloaf

5 lb Ground Beef 3/4 C Sweet Baby Ray's BBQ Sauce 1/2 C Onion, Yellow, Diced 15 oz Stuffing Mix & Seasoning Pkt 6 Eggs

- 1) Preheat oven to 325F.
- 2) Combine all ingredients in a large bowl. Don't overmix.
- 3) Spread mixture into a greased 9x13 pan. Brush top liberally with more BBQ Sauce!
- 4) Cook for 1.5 hours, until the center is brown and reads at 170F.
- 5) Let sit before slicing so it can set.


