Historic Flooding

The Leesville Lake area had a very wet spring that kept the ground saturated. During the week of June 16, 2019 while Mayfield UMC was on site, there was a 3 day period of historic amounts of rain. According to the Army Corps of Engineer's website, we broke the all-time lake level record set in 2011 by a foot. The shore sat at 8.5 feet above its normal

Eat, Sleep, Pray, Repeat was our theme for Summer Camp 2019. While we sure did a lot of eating, and a fair bit of sleeping, during our Bible Study and Vesper services we focused on that third word- Prayer. We took the Lord's prayer and every day broke down a line or two of it. We answered the question: what is prayer and what did Jesus teach us about it? At the end of their week at camp, campers were challenged to



continue their daily morning devotions to stay connected with God.

New High School Intern Program

We are excited to roll out a new High School Internship program in 2020. Most people know the incredible benefits that come from working at Camp. Unfortunately, our young people are encouraged to pass up this incredible growth opportunity to pursue internships that look good on paper, but sadly often are not much more than coffee runs. We had a thought: what if you could get an internship on your resume before you got to college and still get to work at Camp? Well that opportunity is here! We are looking to hire 4 youth between the ages of 16 and 17 that would make a minimum of a 3 week commitment during the summer, plus 2 days of staff training. This new position will work side-by-side with our senior level staff, serving as an assistant in camper groups or assisting behind the scenes on program staff. The internship includes a paid salary of \$100/week plus Room and Board.

Our long-time running F.A.S.T. Academy is not going anywhere: our program for high schoolers that are still looking for their week of camp as a camper, and the possibility of coming back for a week to volunteer.

So what is the main difference between the two programs? F.A.S.T. Academy is for campers, which anyone can register for and attend. Camp Recipe Corner

Peanut Butter Yuckies

- 4 C Graham Cracker Crumbs, fine
- 4 C Powdered Sugar
- 2 C Butter, melted
- 2 C Peanut Butter

Topping:

2.25 C Chocolate Chips

- 1/2 C Peanut Butter
- Combine the graham crackers, peanut butter and powdered sugar.
- 2) Add melted butter and mix well.
- 3) Spread evenly on bottom of greased 9x13" pan.
- 4) Melt the Topping ingredients over double broiler until melted and smooth.
- 5) Spread Topping evenly over peanut butter mixture.
- 6) Cover and refrigerate at least 30 minutes.
- 7) Let sit at room temperature for 30 minutes before cutting.
